Pinot Noir 2017 \$32

Light garnet color. Aromas and flavors of caramel yogurt, buttery toffee, dried cherry, and caramel cheesecake with a supple, bright, fruity light-to-medium body and an even, medium-length finish displaying impressions of caramel pot de creme with light oak flavor. A creamy, caramel Pinot Noir that stands out from the pack. 13% Alc.

Pinot Noir 2018 \$42

Enchanting nose of dried florals, damp earth & warm vanilla. Bright red fruit & a charming acidity mingle with airy tannins leading to a drying finish with notes of spice. 12 months French Oak aged. 13% Alc.

Proprietor Reserve 2019 \$42

Blend: 50% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Carmine Preserved fruit aromas mingle with notes of clove & dried herbs. Medium bodied with woody tannins that are balanced by a mouthwatering acidity. Dried florals, dark fruits & cacao on the palate with hints of vanilla on the finish. Muscato 2022 \$26

Lychee, orange blossom, & ripe clementine greet the nose with notes of candied pineapple, sweet tarts, & soft peach dancing on the palate. Fresh zesty acidity right up front that leads to an elegantly clean finish leaving your mouth yearning for more. 8% Alc.
