

WINE TASTING with Katie and Sharon, March 21, 2025

Rieslings and a Couple Friends

1) Ruhlman Reisling Vieilles Vignes 2021 \$16.99

Aromas of blackcurrant and lemongrass. *Very floral with a dominance of riesling fruitiness. Predominant taste of lychees and mandarins.*

2) Long Shadows Poets Leap Riesling 2022 \$19.99

.. actually leaps from the glass and into your senses. Made in a dry style with boisterous aromas of grated lime zest, stone fruits, red apples, crushed limestone, and just a hint of petrol, which will become more prominent as it ages.

3) Barth Riesling Fructus 2022 \$19.99

concentrated aromas of ripe peach, apricot, and refreshing lemon complemented by a delicate hint of Italian herbs and a subtle touch of dry stone minerality... the presence of classic Rheingau loess clay allows for a gentle fermentation process.

4) Kendall Jackson Vintner's Reserve 2023 \$10.49

intricate layers of apricot, almond, and honeysuckle. Vineyard soils are decomposed granite and alluvial benchland over an ancient river bed.

5) Dr. Konstantin Frank Semi Dry Riesling 2023 \$17.99

delicate aromas of acacia flowers intermingle with hints of green apple and lime create a fresh and vibrant profile; subtle and distinct mineral character

6) Castor Cellars Estate Grown Sauvignon Blanc 2023 \$15.99

Lively aromas of lime peel, chopped grass, kiwi and rainy concrete decorate the nose, while the palate is boosted by a zesty, citrus-powered acidity and a stony grip, with grass clippings most prevalent.

7) Paul Doucet et Fils Sancerre Blanc 2023 \$22.99

bright citrus notes of lemon and grapefruit, complemented by white peach and green apple. A distinctive flinty minerality adds complexity, while lively acidity provides a crisp, refreshing finish.
